Did You Know

Did you know that Lake Kivu hosts approximately 28 fish species, with half of them being cichlids unique to this lake? As the largest local fish source in Rwanda, Lake Kivu contributes over 20,000 tons of fish annually, reducing the need for fish imports and bolstering animal protein availability. This thriving fishery sustains the livelihoods of around 500,000 people in both Rwanda and the Democratic Republic of Congo.

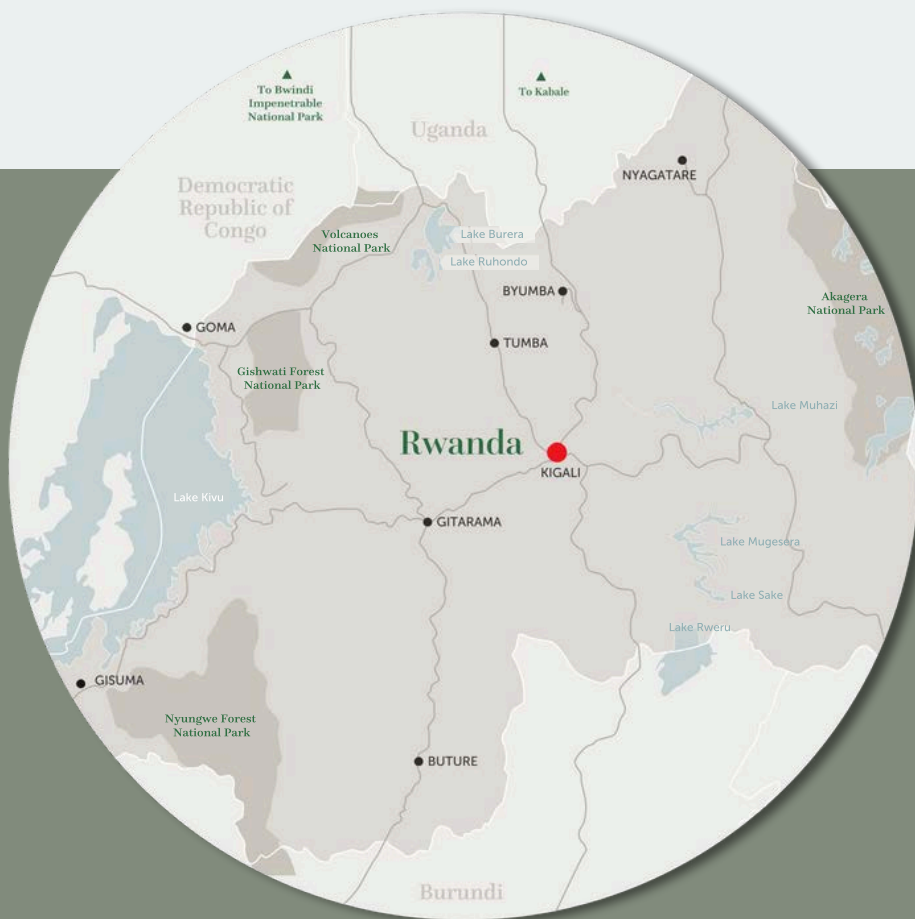
GORILLA TREKKING ADVENTURE

WHAT TO EXPECT ON YOUR JOURNEY

GORILLA TREKKING IN RWANDA

Encounter an awe-inspiring and transformative journey, often hailed as a profound experience; meet the majestic giants of the jungle and their kin, dwelling harmoniously in their native realm.



WILDLIFE & NATURE

Witnessing the magnificent mountain gorillas is an indescribable wildlife encounter. Every moment spent observing family groups—whether foraging, playing, teasing, eating, or resting—offers a remarkable glimpse into their lives, often mirroring our own.

CHALLENGING TREKKING

Trails for trekking are moderately open with some forest density, avoiding excessively steep or slippery terrain. However, trekking at high altitudes demands a decent level of physical fitness, as the primates are constantly on the move, making the journey physically demanding.

For less fit guests, local stretcher or sedan chair transport to tracking points is available.

EXPERT GUIDANCE

Knowledgeable guides and trackers ensure your time in Rwanda is filled with memorable experiences, enriching your understanding of the local wildlife and habitats.

CAPTIVATING ENCOUNTERS

Trekking can span up to eight hours, culminating in an unforgettable encounter with these iconic and endangered creatures. Sitting amidst the lush rainforest, knowing you're in the presence of such rare beings, creates an extraordinary sense of connection.

QUIET REFLECTION

Once the gorillas are located, guests are granted a maximum observation period of one hour before returning to the base station, allowing for quiet contemplation and appreciation of the experience.

BEST TIME

Trekking commences year-round Best time to trek is during the dry season December to February and June to September

CLIMATE

Average temperature: 05 - 15°C (41 - 59°F) to 15 - 25°C (45 - 77°F) Rainy seasons: March to end May (long rain) October to November (short rain)

HIKE DURATION

Rigorous trekking can take up to eight hours

GROUP SIZE

Maximum of eight visitors a day per family group

GORILLA GROUP SIZE

Approx 13 family group

Family Groups

Rwanda's Volcanoes National Park is home to around 13 mountain gorilla family groups. While some are available for trekking, others undergo regular research and monitoring by conservation organizations within the park. These family groups typically roam throughout the park, often changing locations.

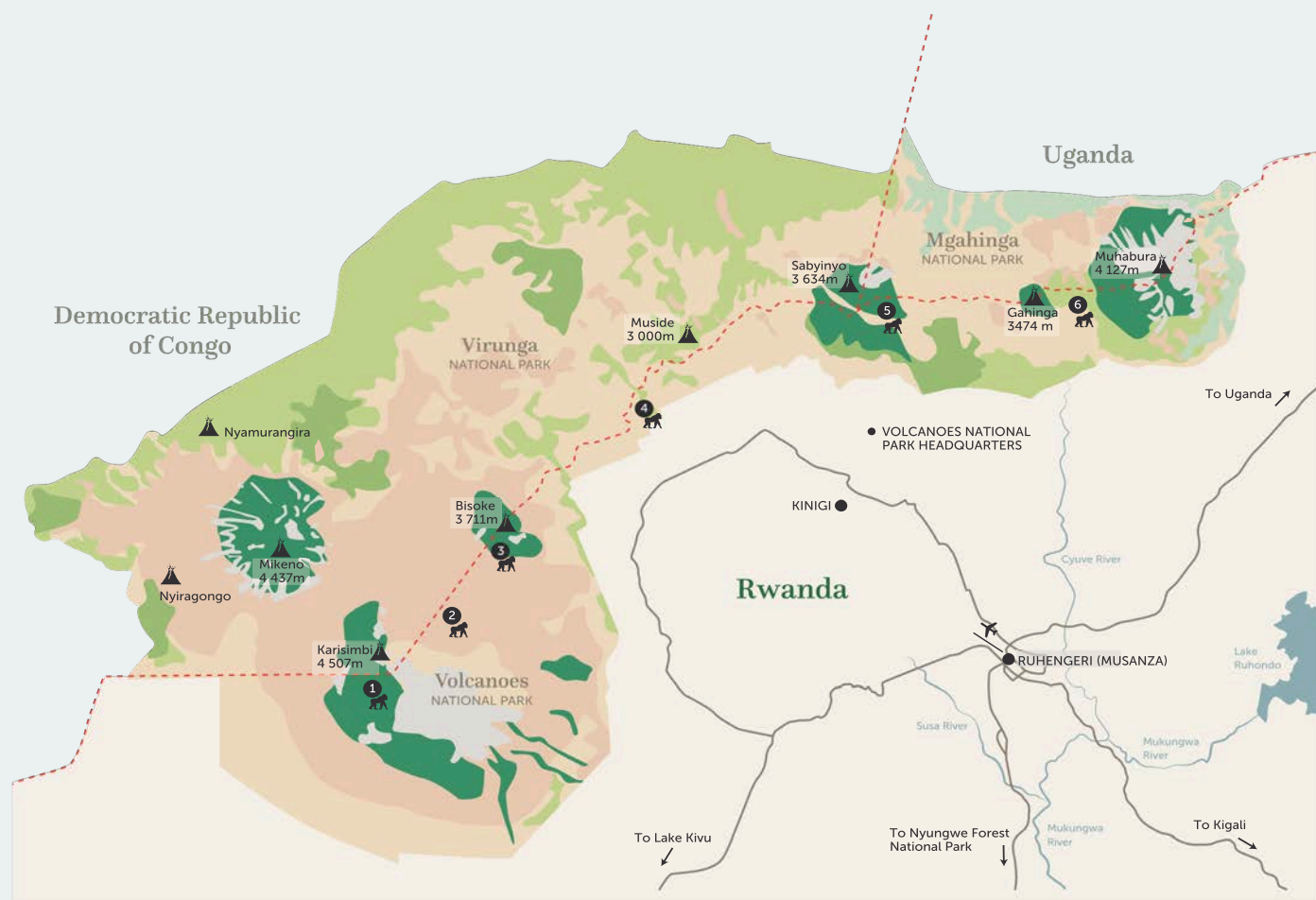

SIMPLIFIED GORILLA PERMIT PROCUREMENT

What are they and how to get them:

To track mountain gorillas in Rwanda or lowland gorillas in the Republic of Congo, permits are required and purchased per person, per trek. A percentage of each permit supports local communities and park infrastructure. We simplify the process by organizing permits without charging extra fees, ensuring the same cost whether obtained through us or directly from the park.

Mountain Gorilla Permit	\$1,500
Golden Monkey Permit	\$100
Chimp Permit	\$90
Canopy Walk Permit	\$60



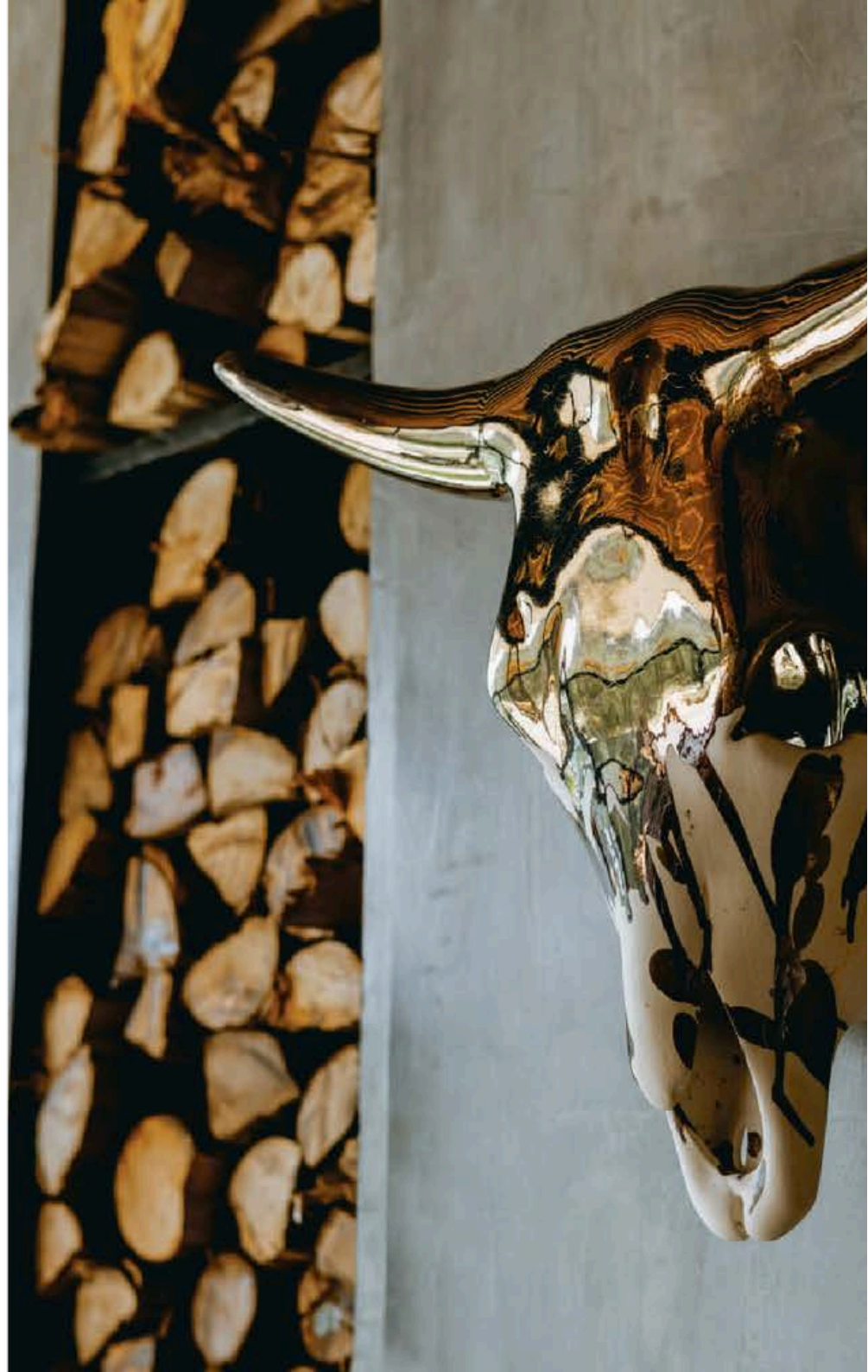

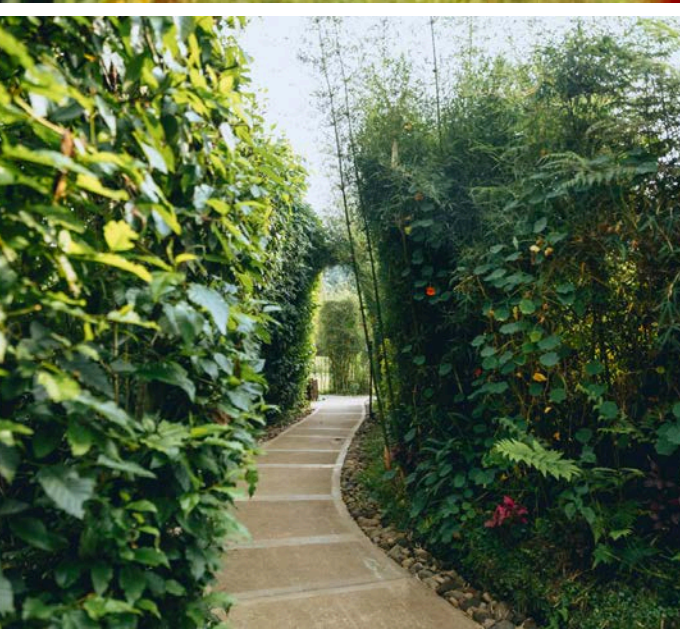
